This Notice informs you of the determination that you are not entitled to an award in the TV Writers Case settlement and your right to challenge that determination.

I. DETERMINATION OF NON-ENTITLEMENT TO AN AWARD

It has been determined that you are not entitled to an award from the TV Writers Settlement Fund for the reason(s) below that have been checked:

- You submitted your claim form between April 13, 2010 and June 9, 2010 without an adequate excuse for your late submission;
- You submitted your claim form after June 9, 2010;
- You did not cure the deficiency(ies) identified below in your claim form of which you were notified:

II. CHALLENGING THE DETERMINATION

You may challenge the determination that you are not entitled to an award on any of the following bases that apply to you:

If the first box above is checked	You have an adequate excuse for submitting your claim form between April 13, 2010 (the deadline for claim form submissions) and June 9, 2010. If you rely on this basis, YOU MUST PROVIDE AN ADEQUATE EXCUSE for filing your claim form after April 13th AND for failing to provide an excuse previously.
If the second box above is checked	You submitted your claim form no later than June 9, 2010; if the submission was between April 13, 2010 and June 9, 2010, you MUST ALSO provide an adequate excuse for submitting the claim form after the deadline. If you rely on this basis, YOU MUST DOCUMENT WHEN YOUR CLAIM FORM WAS SUBMITTED.
If the third box above is checked	Your claim form was not deficient in the manner indicated above or you cured the deficiency at some time before January 10, 2011. If you rely on this basis, YOU MUST DOCUMENT THAT YOUR CLAIM FORM WAS NOT DEFICIENT OR THAT IT WAS CURED.

If it is determined that you are entitled to an award, it will be paid from the Claimant Challenge Reserve. The amount of this reserve is \$175,000.00 and ALL increases in awards based on challenges will be paid from this fund. If the total amount of increases resulting from successful challenges exceeds \$175,000.00, individual increases will be reduced proportionately so that the total amount doesn't exceed \$175,000.00.

You have until **February 10, 2011** to send a written challenge to the award on the accompanying Challenge Form based on one or more of the grounds above. A challenge shall be deemed mailed on the postmark date if sent by first class or other category of U.S. postal service or private courier. Challenges should be mailed to:

Faxed and electronic submissions will not be accepted. Late submissions will not be considered.

After you submit a challenge, you will receive a written acknowledgement of receipt. Other than that acknowledgement, Class Counsel will not discuss your challenge with you. We intend to rely only on the information on your Challenge Form and on the Claim Form and other submissions that you made to the Claims Administrator in evaluating your challenge, not on orally transmitted information or on information submitted after the deadline for challenging your award.

Lead Class Counsel will analyze the timely-filed challenges by March 14, 2011, unless more than 150 timely challenges are received, in which case the deadline shall be extended as set forth in Administrative Order No. 5. Lead Class Counsel will report to the Court his recommended adjustments, if any, to determinations that claimants are not entitled to awards, and the reasons for the recommendations. Awards will be made to challengers only after the Court has issued an Order approving and/or altering the recommendations and the awardees submit their W-9 form.

If you do nothing, you will not receive an award from the Settlement Fund. If you challenge this determination, your challenge will be reviewed but there is no assurance the determination will be reversed.
